**Newmarket, ON** – The Canadian Institute of Public Health Inspectors (CIPHI) is pleased to announce the appointment of Dr. Andrew Papadopoulos as editor of the Environmental Health Review (EHR). Cameron Weighill, EHR Transition Committee Chair, said “The new editorship was an important step towards ensuring that environmental public health professionals across Canada are informed of the latest research, analysis and policy statements on environmental health related programming and have access to current best practices and standards.”

Dr. Papadopoulos is currently the Associate Professor and Coordinator of the Master of Public Health Program at the University of Guelph. There, he is responsible for the coordination of the MPH program and also teaches three core courses. Prior to joining the University of Guelph, Dr. Papadopoulos was the Director at the School of Occupational and Public Health at Ryerson University. In his role at Ryerson University, he was responsible for the overall operation of the program and ensuring the curriculum remained relevant to public health inspectors. Dr. Papadopoulos received his CPHI (C) designation in 1988, his MBA from York University in 1998 and his PhD from the University of Guelph in 2011.

In his role as editor, Dr. Papadopoulos is responsible for coordinating all aspects of publication and ensuring the EHR remains a leader in the publication of scholarly articles in the field of environmental public health practice, administration, management, leadership, research and other related fields. He will be responsible to maintain a high standard for the EHR and for the selection and substantive editing of journal contents.
